## To whom it may concern:

This letter confirms that A-LIGN conducted a Type 2 SSAE 16 examination of the Title Insurance and Settlement services provided by ATA National Title Group, in accordance with the American Land Title Association (ALTA) Best Practices System at its Michigan, Ohio, Indiana, and Illinois Title office locations. The examination was conducted as of the specified review period.

The examination of ATA National Title Group's description of the system for the Title Insurance and Settlement Services in accordance with ALTA Best Practices were performed to determine whether or not, in all material respects and based upon suitable criteria:

- The written assertion, as provided by Management of the Service Organization, fairly presents the System that was designed and implemented for the period January 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016;
- The controls related to the control objectives stated in the description were suitably designed to provide reasonable assurance that the control objectives would be achieved if the controls operated effectively for the period January 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016 and user entities applied the complementary user entity controls contemplated in the design of Management's controls for the period January 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016;
- The controls tested, which together with the complementary user entity controls referred to in the scope paragraph of this report, if operating effectively, were those necessary to provide reasonable assurance that the control objectives stated in the description were achieved, operated effectively for the period January 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016.
